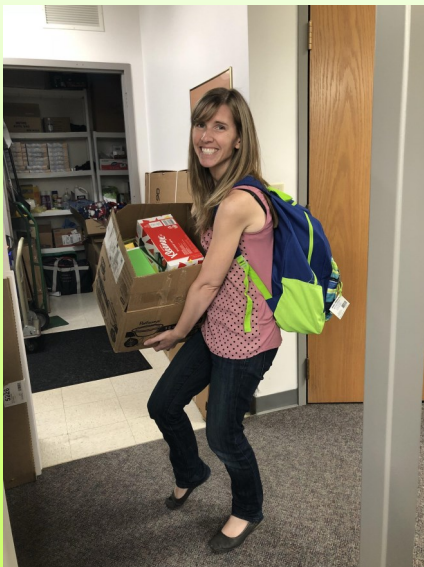

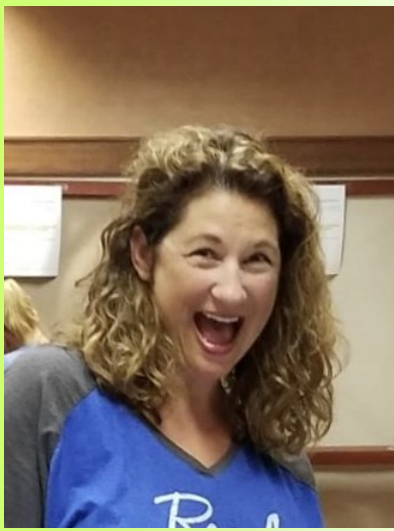

Greetings! Happy new school year to all! This past summer we were quite busy with our summer reading program and library building projects that took place. I will say with the new paint in the lobby and conference room, the library feels fresh and we are ready for the new school year to begin!

We would like to thank all of those that donated school supplies during the month of August. It feels good to start the new school year with new supplies. And with the new school year I would like to remind everyone of the library's unattended child policy. The KJM library welcomes the use of all children and young adults; however the unattended child policy is in place for everyone's safety and well being.

All children eight (8) years of age or younger shall, at all times, be attended and supervised by a responsible adult or mature adolescent twelve (12) years of age or older. Children nine (9) years through twelve (12) years of age may use the library unattended providing proper behavior is maintained. However, if these children come to the library on a regular basis they may only stay at the library for two hours each day. All children and young adults should have the name and telephone number of someone who can assist them in an emergency or if they are asked to leave the library due to not following the libraries code of conduct rules. If a child is asked to leave the library, the child's guardian will need to sign the unattended child form that will be sent with the child, in order for the child to return to the library.
