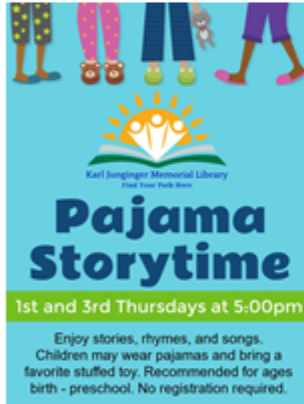


Needle Crafters Club

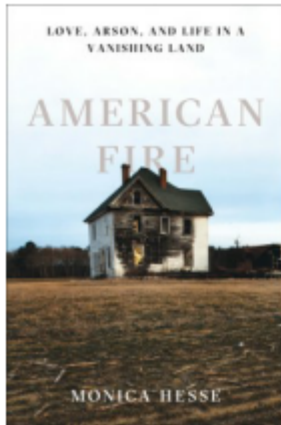
