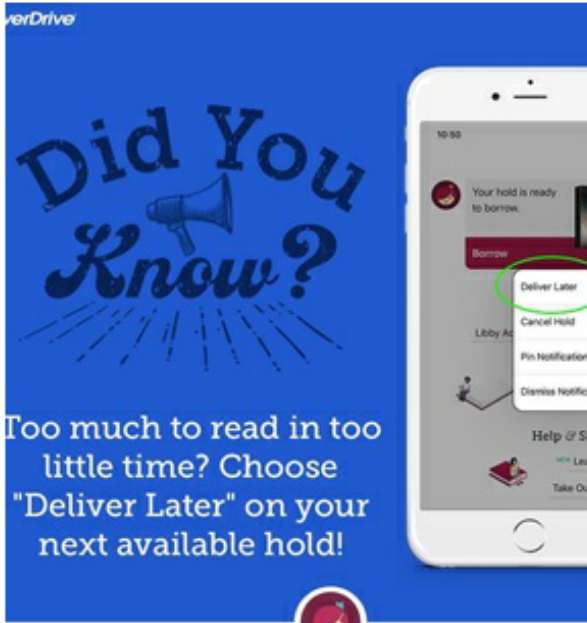
WI Historical Society Traveling Display

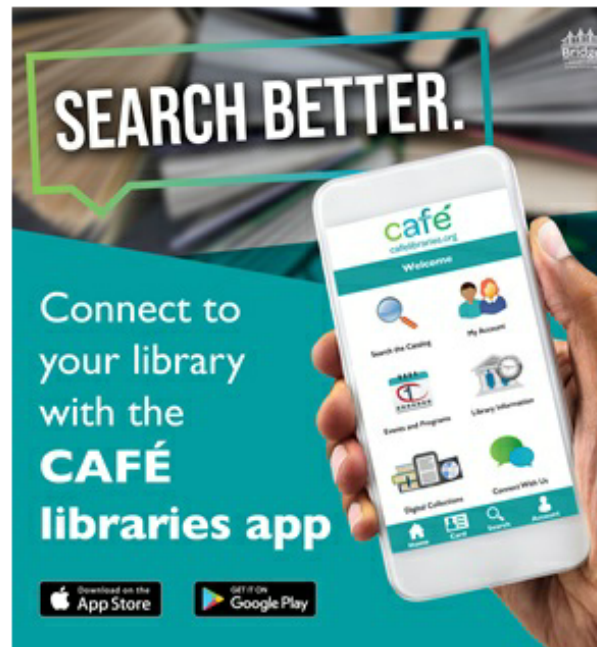
Deliver Later
